

3.5 mm Coaxial Fixed Attenuator, 6 dB Attenuation, 10 W

SCA-06-3M3F-SD-40 is a 6 dB coaxial attenuator that is used in millimeterwave systems and operates from DC to 33 GHz. The attenuator has a typical attenuation value of 6 dB across the frequency range. While the attenuator is designed and fabricated for full 3.5 mm coaxial band applications, the attenuation value of this model will have a wide range due to its broadband coverage. Various attenuation values are available under different model numbers.


