SWC-1208F-E1 and SWC-1208M-E1 are end launch (180°) E-Band waveguide to coax adapters that cover the frequency range of 60 to 90 GHz. They are designed and manufactured for instrumentation grade quality but offered at a commercial grade price, allowing for an efficient transition between the rectangular waveguide and 0.8 mm coax connector.

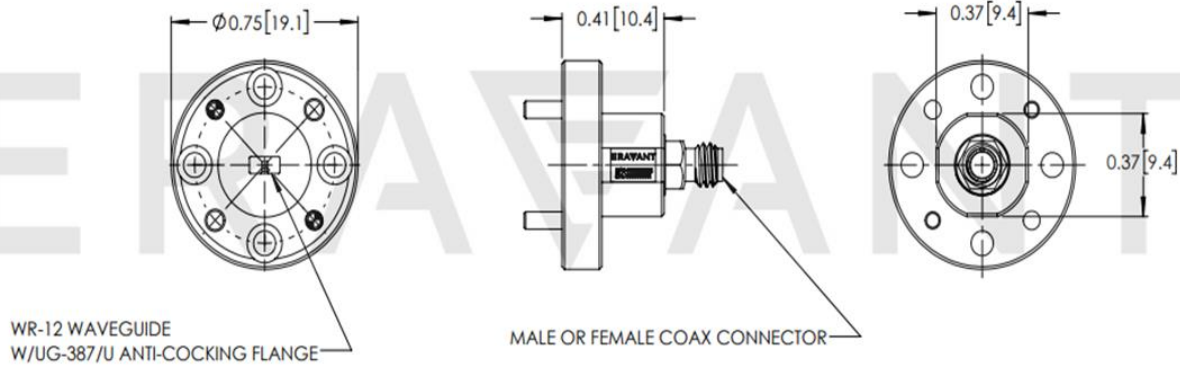
